COVID 19 POLICY 12th May 2020

- A maximum of two people from different households can play together, or a maximum of four from the same household.
- Arrive no earlier than 20 minutes before your tee time, following social distancing requirements in the car park.
 - The current car-park layout can remain with no need for extra distancing. Please change your shoes and organise your golf equipment in the car park as the lockers are now closed.
 - Everyone must sign in at Pro Shop before playing.
 - Tee times must be pre-booked.
 - The Golf Course is open from 8am (weekdays) & 7.30am (weekends).
 - The Clubhouse Bar will remain closed, please do not gather in the clubhouse.
 - Locker rooms are closed, please let us know if you need to access your belongings.
 - The Driving Range will remain closed until further notice.
 - The toilets inside the Clubhouse will be open with soap and hot water for hand washing. Regular cleaning of the facilities will be implemented. Only one person at a time in the toilets.
 - The use of golf buggies is prohibited at this time.
 - The defibrillator will be positioned in the Pro Shop.
- If any member that has played golf at the club subsequently develops symptoms or tests positive for Coronavirus, they should inform the Operations Director immediately so that the appropriate steps can be taken.
 - NO GOLF is permitted outside the stipulated tee times.
 - We remind golfers not to touch any golf ball other than their own.
 - All the litter bins have been removed. Please take your own litter away at the end of your round.
 - Golfers are reminded to leave the golf course as soon as possible after their round to avoid social gatherings.
 - We will update any changes on our new website & mailing list.
